NAME HISTORY:

The journal ANALELE UNIVERSITATII DIN ORADEA FASCICULA LIMBA SI LITERATURA ROMANA has more than 30 years of effective presence in the field of academic research.

The journal was founded in 1966, by the group of young researchers who were all academics at the Institute of Higher Education in Oradea. They attracted prestigious collaborations of a national impact. The first issue was published in 1967: http://analeromana.uoradea.ro/1967.pdf under the name "Lucrări Stiintifice", the former Annals of the Institute of Higher Education in Oradea. In 1990, when the Institute became the University of Oradea (previous name: Technical University of Oradea), the same

nucleus of researchers in Philology, along with their younger colleagues, prepared the first issue of academic journal with a changed name and format. The year 1991 marks the beginning of the new series.

Since 1991, Analele Universității din Oradea Fascicula Limba și Literatura Română has been published constantly with few exceptions (the years 1994, 1995, 2006)

Analele Universitatii din Oradea Fascicula Limba si Literatura Romana has been published under this series name since 1991.

"Analele Universitatii din Oradea - Fascicola Filologie" was the title assigned when the researches on Romanian language and literature were grouped together with the researches on foreign languages, in one journal, between 1991-1993, ISSN 1221-129X. In 1996, the title became "ANALELE UNIVERSITATII DIN ORADEA. SERIA FILOLOGIE. LIMBA ŞI LITERATURA ROMÂNĂ." The journal received the ISSN 1224-7588 in 1996, when it split into Fascicula Limba si Literatura Română and Fascicula Limba şi Literatura Engleză. "Seria Filologie" is the indicator of the domain, used to distinguish between various general fields of the Annals of the University of Oradea. Analele Universității din Oradea. Seria Filologie had two fascicules: Fascicula Limba şi Literatura Română and Fascicula Limba şi Literatura Engleză. A third fascicule of the same Seria Filologie appeared in 1997, Fascicula Limba şi Literatura Franceză. Later this one merged with the second fascicule.

"Fascicula Limba și Literatura Română "is the narrower field of specialization within the larger domain. The second fascicule of the same "Seria Filologie", focused on modern languages, evolved in a separate journal with its own ISSN. It has become the journal *Confluente. Analele Universitatii din Oradea. Fascicula Limbi și Literaturi moderne*, ISSN: 1842-622X.

Since 2001, the words "Seria Filologie" have not appeared in the title of the journal. This fact is due to the separate evolution of the second fascicule, now a completely separate journal with its own research aims. After the split, there was only one fascicule left with the ISSN 1224-7588. Therefore, Seria (the larger domain) referred to the same thing as Fascicula, the narrower domain, since there was only one journal with that description. Analele Universitatii din Oradea. Seria Filologie. Limba si Literatura Română and Analele Universității din Oradea Fascicula Limba și Literatura Română are the same journal. In 1996 the journal was not published by the Faculty of Letters, it was published by the Faculty of Letters and Socio-Humanistic Sciences, because the University of Oradea had a different division of sections. ANALELE UNIVERSITĂȚII DIN ORADEA FASCICULA LIMBA ȘI LITERATURA ROMÂNĂ relies on this over 30 years of tradition to create a larger international impact in the present.
